Camper

Youth Volunteer

- Must be the child, grandchild or legal dependant of an active or retired Oklahoma National Guard member.
- Must be between the ages of 14 to 18.
- Must submit a Letter of Recommendation along with their application.
- Must be courteous to campers, peers and adult volunteers.

Adult Volunteer

- Must be fun-loving and enjoy working with children.
- There are many positions that require full time volunteers, however part-time volunteers are also appreciated.
