Eligibility: National Guard (NG) technicians who are placed in an LWOP-US status due to Active Duty.

Effective Date: 22 June 1998

Use: When National Guard technicians are placed in a Leave Without Pay – Uniform Service (LWOP-US) due to being placed on active duty orders, they may exercise their restoration rights at the conclusion of the active duty orders. If the technician wishes to exercise their restoration rights during their military Terminal Leave, they must submit a Standard Form 52 along with a copy of the approved Terminal Leave request to OKHR. The technician will be allowed to return to duty on any date after the beginning of the Terminal Leave.
