Eligibility: Current National Guard (NG) Technicians

Effective Date: 1 January 2009

Use: To provide the Federal Holidays for the calendar year 2009.

1. The Office of Personnel Management publishes when the Federal Holidays will be in accordance with 5 U.S.C. 6103. Following is a list of the Federal Holidays for the calendar year 2009:

Thursday, January 1	New Year's Day
Monday, January 19	Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr.
Monday, February 16	Washington's Birthday
Monday, May 25	Memorial Day
Friday, July 3	Independence Day
Monday, September 7	Labor Day
Monday, October 12	Columbus Day
Wednesday, November 11	Veterans Day
Thursday, November 26	Thanksgiving Day
Friday, December 25	Christmas Day

2. All Federal Employees, Active Guard Reserve (AGR) and State personnel employed with the Oklahoma National Guard may be authorized Liberal Leave around the Federal Holidays. Leave must be granted by your supervisor. Supervisors may allow employees to use any authorized leave while maintaining the minimum staffing level required to answer public inquiries and conduct public business. **NOTE:** Personnel not on duty during these days must be in an authorized leave status unless it is a regularly scheduled day off.
